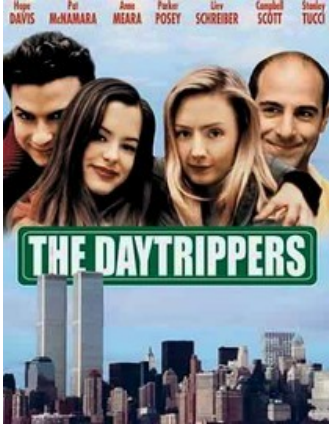


# Community Dinner and a Movie
