### **Full-day Silver Camp Program • Monday – Friday 8:30am–3:30pm • The Children's Tent**

A full day-camp experience is offered to interested campers entering grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. In addition to the traditional morning program, this extended program will offer participants daily swim lessons and extended recreation programs across the Silver Bay campus. Guests in cottages or members off-campus should provide a bag lunch for their child; Guests using the Dining Hall during their stay should contact the Front Desk to order bag lunches. Registration is required and is offered at \$72 per child per week for Silver Bay program members. For non-members, registration is offered at \$108 per child per week.

Need childcare in the evening? ChildWatch is available to assist Silver Bay families, guests, and conference participants. Trained staff provides supervised, age appropriate activities for children ages 6 weeks +. ChildWatch reservations should be made at the Front Desk by 6 pm of the night it is needed. ChildWatch will only be offered if 4 or more children have been signed up for the program. Please check back at the Front Desk before taking your children to the Children's Pavilion to confirm the session will be running. 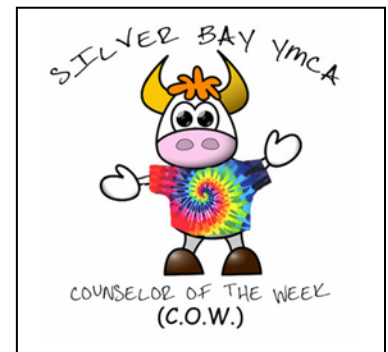
## Camper of the Week & Counselor of the Week
