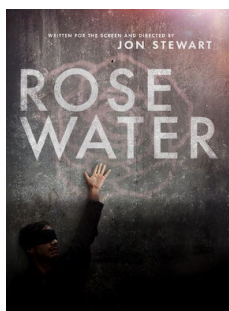

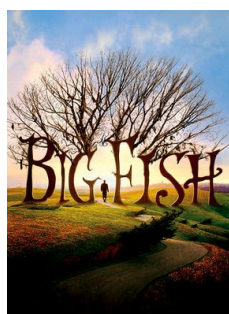

Rosewater (2014)

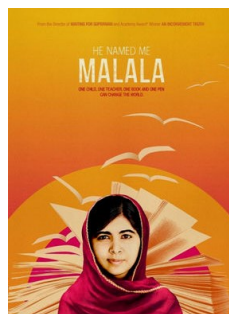
