“The lineup for our Summer Concert Series this year includes artists from varying genres. One week we have a Christian jazz singer, and another we have a funk band. We wanted to change it up this year and make sure we brought some new genres to our stage, and I think we accomplished just that,” Silver Bay YMCA’s Arts and Humanities Supervisor Madeline Drexler stated.

Genres represented in this year's Summer Concert Series includes Christian jazz, alternative/indie, folk, reggae, Americana, bluegrass, Venezuelan and Appalachian folk music, classical, traditional West African music, funk, and country.

"We're excited for this year's lineup as the majority of them will be coming to Silver Bay for the first time," said Silver Bay YMCA's Assistant VP of Campus and Conference Programming Chet Lastowski.
