There are a multitude of outdoor activities; hikes, archery, boating, etc. We are opening our Summer Concert Series that Saturday evening, followed by a fireworks show. Families will be able to participate and compete in a number of games and fun activities. We will be making sure to recognize the significance of the weekend with a Remembrance Salute for those who gave all in service to our country," Lastowski added.

Silver Bay YMCA's Executive Chef and Kitchen Manager Anthony Basile spoke to the upcoming food service-related events.

"It is an exciting year for us here at Silver Bay! We are offering multiple different events and extras from the Food Service department to continue to provide our guests and patrons with fresh, quality meals as well as a different experience.
