Childcare Scholarships For Working Families

Don't qualify for NYS childcare subsidies? Get the help you need with a scholarship!

The Ticonderoga Community Early Learning Center (TCELC) is currently enrolling children for infant, toddler, and preschool childcare, and offering scholarships for working families. Many families that are not eligible for NYS low-income childcare subsidies are now eligible for two generous scholarship programs designed to support working families that did not qualify for subsidies because of income or other reasons.

Step 1: Contact us we can help you navigate the resources

Step 2: Visit the state childcare subsidy website at

https://ocfs.ny.gov/programs/childcare/ccap/help.php#CCAP-income. Fill out the paperwork, even if you know you will be denied support. Step 3: Circle back to the Early Learning Center for help with your scholarship application.

I'm working, I don't qualify for state subsidy, but I still need some help! --- Try the New York State Childcare Scholarship Program

The Childcare Scholarship Program is separate from the low-income childcare subsidy program and is administered through the Workforce Development Institute. The program is designed for working families whose income is above the limits of the subsidy program. The program awards an average monthly scholarship of \$1,000 per child for full-time care paid directly to the childcare provider on behalf of the family. More than 80% of those who complete a pre-screen assessment qualify for assistance. There are still a few restrictions. The applicants must be either working or enrolled in an educational or training program for a minimum of 10 hours per week and meet the income criteria in the table below. Still can't meet the requirements? Are there other circumstances to consider? --- Talk to us at TCELC about a private scholarship.

A number of private scholarships are available to help those who, for whatever reason, still can't meet the state's criteria. A private scholarship can cover up to 50% of childcare cost. Every child in our community deserves the benefit of early childhood education. If you need childcare, talk to us about how we can help.
