Silver Bay YMCA is pleased to announce its Evenings of Dance event is returning for the third year. This event initially launched in August of 2019 but was delayed from returning for the following two years due to COVID-19. Last year, the event was able to return to Silver Bay fully and safely and is now on track to becoming a permanent addition to Silver Bay's free community events summer line up.

I have experienced and witnessed how impactful it has been on my friends and family's lives, and I treasure having had the privilege to visit every year of my life. Having the opportunity to organize Evenings of Dance is an important responsibility, and one I cherish."

This year Evenings of Dance will take place on the 18 and 19 of August at 7:30 p.m. The performance should last about an hour. Dancers include Devon Teuscher, Chun Wai Chan, Roman Zhurbin, SunMi Park, Demi Remick, Unity Phelan, and Stearns who wanted to bring this event to Silver Bay where he spent his summer's growing up attending Silver Camp.

"We are thrilled to bring Cory and his team of world-renowned dancers from ABT and NYC Ballet back to Silver Bay this summer. This quality of the performances curated by Cory and intimacy of the lakeside setting make for an astonishingly unforgettable experience," a Hague resident said.

General admission for this event is free and open to the public, although tickets must be reserved to guarantee there are enough seats for everybody. A VIP Access ticket is available for purchase for \$75 and grants access to a VIP entrance line, preferred seating in the front-center of

the Auditorium, a post-performance gala at the Silver Bay Boathouse where attendees will be able to meet and greet with the dancers while enjoying refreshments, wine, beer, and cider.

"Being able to provide the members of our community with an opportunity to experience performers of this caliber is truly a gift," Chet Lastowski assistant vice president of campus and conference programs said.
